The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the team representative, have considered the following matter and determined the following:

Entrant: Mahiki Racing (MSUK: 407208)

Session: Qualifying 4 - GT4

Time (Fact): 18:45

Fact: Car 84 was reported to have been placed on jacks after chequered flag shown for Q4

Offence: Breach of Article 41.4.2 of the British GT Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations 2025 and Race Director's Briefing

Notes

Decision: Disqualification from Q3 and Q4

Reason: The Stewards summoned and heard from the Competitor's representative and watched two video clips which showed car 84

lifted onto jacks after the chequered flag for Q4 had been shown and, therefore, indicating that parc ferme conditions had commenced. Joe Osborne, on behalf of the Competitor, did not dispute what had occurred. Mr Osborne advised that no competitive advantage had been sought or obtained by the actions. The Stewards are satisfied that, notwithstanding Mr Osborne's statements, a breach had occurred. Having considered all options, the Stewards award the penalty cited here.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards. Any Notice of Intention to Appeal a Decision of the Stewards to the National Court must be lodged in accordance with NCR Ch.2, App.4, Arts.1.16 – 1.18 accompanied by a signed undertaking to pay the Fee (NCR Ch.1, App.2, Art.11.4.iii).
