The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the driver(s) and team representative(s), have considered the following matter and determined the following:

<b>No / Driver:</b>	88 / Joe Wheeler (MSUK: 335716)
<b>Session:</b>	Pre-Qualifying
<b>Time (Fact):</b>	17:42
<b>Fact:</b>	Excessive speed under Full Course Yellow conditions
<b>Offence:</b>	Breach of Article 46.4 of the British GT Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations
<b>Decision:</b>	Fine 375 GBP
<b>Reason:</b>	The Competitor and Team Manager were invited to attend the Stewards Office. The driver Joe Wheeler (car #88 - Mahiki Racing) was shown evidence that the car's speed was in excess of 80 kph during a Full Course Yellow period, to a maximum of 95 kph. Both the competitor and TM were advised of the safety implications of this exceedance; they were further advised that the fine must be paid to Motorsport UK.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards. Any Notice of Intention to Appeal a Decision of the Stewards to the National Court must be lodged in accordance with NCR Ch.2, App.4, Arts.1.16 – 1.18 accompanied by a signed undertaking to pay the Fee (NCR Ch.1, App.2, Art.11.4.iii).
