The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the driver(s) and team representative(s), have considered the following matter and determined the following:

Entrant: Bridger Motorsport (MSUK: 501005)
Session: Warm Up
Time (Fact): 10:36
Fact: Lack of working pit area camera
Offence: Breach of Appendix 10 of the British GT Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations 2025
Decision: Fine 500 GBP
Reason: The Team Manager of car 86 was invited to attend the Stewards Office, since the Stewards had received a report that refuelling had taken place on that car prior to the warm up session. The TM was adamant that the team were practicing a pitstop, but that no fuel had passed into the car. The pit lane marshal concerned was also interviewed, who could not be sure that any fuel had passed into the car. However the TM was unable to produce any footage since the pit area camera was not functioning. The TM was advised that the fine must be paid to Motorsport UK.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards. Any Notice of Intention to Appeal a Decision of the Stewards to the National Court must be lodged in accordance with NCR Ch.2, App.4, Arts.1.16 – 1.18 accompanied by a signed undertaking to pay the Fee (NCR Ch.1, App.2, Art.11.4.iii).
