The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the driver(s) and team representative(s), have considered the following matter and determined the following:

<b>No / Driver:</b>	71 / Ravi Ramyeed (MSUK: 195491)
<b>Session:</b>	Race
<b>Time (Fact):</b>	17:53
<b>Fact:</b>	Breach of Safety Car regulations; car 71 overtook car 30 during Safety Car restart procedure, but before the control line; gaining an advantage.
<b>Offence:</b>	Breach of Article 46.7 of the British GT Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations 2025
<b>Decision:</b>	Time penalty of 10.0 seconds to be added to the elapsed race time, plus 1 x BWP for competitor R Ramyeed
<b>Reason:</b>	The TM involved was invited to the Stewards, where in car footage from car 71 was viewed. It was clear that whilst green signals were showing, the race remained under SC conditions when this overtake took place. 1 x BWP to competitor Ravi Ramyeed.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards. Any Notice of Intention to Appeal a Decision of the Stewards to the National Court must be lodged in accordance with NCR Ch.2, App.4, Arts.1.16 – 1.18 accompanied by a signed undertaking to pay the Fee (NCR Ch.1, App.2, Art.11.4.iii).
