The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the driver(s) and team representative(s), have considered the following matter and determined the following:

<b>Entrant:</b>	Kessel Racing (ASS: 37)
<b>Session:</b>	Race
<b>Time (Fact):</b>	17:56
<b>Fact:</b>	Breach of parc ferme conditions
<b>Offence:</b>	Breach of Article 49.1 of the British GT Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations 2025
<b>Decision:</b>	Car 74 is disqualified from the results of the race
<b>Reason:</b>	The Stewards met with the Team Manager, who was shown photographic evidence from a Judge of Fact that an individual from the team had entered the vehicle whilst under parc ferme conditions, which was confirmed by the Competitor's representative. The Stewards are satisfied that there had been a breach of the Regulations and that the appropriate penalty is as stated above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards. Any Notice of Intention to Appeal a Decision of the Stewards to the National Court must be lodged in accordance with NCR Ch.2, App.4, Arts.1.16 – 1.18 accompanied by a signed undertaking to pay the Fee (NCR Ch.1, App.2, Art.11.4.iii).
