




















Pit Exit Demarcation White line



PIT LANE ENTRY - STAY RIGHT OF BOLLARD












SPEED LIMIT PIT LANE Speed Controlled by Radar & GPS

If you overtake under a yellow flag, expect ACTION









RED Flag

You are reminded of Championship regulation 42.1

When the red flag is deployed all cars shall immediately reduce speed to 80km/h.



Driving Standards:

When leaving the pit lane/out lap
Do not weave across the track
RESPECT CARS ON A HOT LAP

GT3 Cars must respect GT4 cars when overtaking Do not force cars out onto the dirty side of track







Driving Standards:

Drivers in both classes must take care whilst overtaking during all sessions.

GT3 and GT4 cars are clearly identified:

GT4 have BLACK windscreen banners and yellow headlights

GT3 have WHITE windscreen banners

Rear ID in both classes GT3 and GT4 stickers

Yellow Flag infringements

If you overtake under a yellow SIGNAL/flag, expect ACTION





FP; persistent offenders- black flag (stop/go) Both drivers report to race control



Race penalty menu:

Track limit infringements in <u>3hr race</u> = 2 x TSL Screen warnings,

3rd infringement is B/W flag,

4th is a drive through penalty,

then B/W Flag again

6th is a drive through penalty,

per car not driver, total race, reset on the HOUR.







Race penalty menu:

IN THE EVENT THAT THE NUMBER OF TRACK LIMIT REPORTS IS EXCESSIVE

Electronic monitoring reports will continue to be investigated after the sessions if there is not sufficient time during the session.

Penalties will continue to accumulate and will be applied post session using evidence that is presented by the systems.

FULL COURSE YELLOW - FCY



- Radio message "prepare full course yellow in 20s"
- At 10s- waved flags / yellow signals displayed
- no overtaking
- DO NOT STAMP ON YOUR BRAKES!!
- PREPARE TO SLOW TO 80
- At ZERO s, FCY displayed on light panels = 80KPH
- all cars at 80KPH

























Short Full Course Yellow – 3 hour race

NOT IN USE THIS WEEKEND





Long Full Course Yellow – 3 hour race



- MIN 2 LAPS
- Radio message "long full course yellow"
- When race control ready, SC will join the track without lights
- SC will position itself in front of overall race leader
- Race control will declare "safety car procedure"
- SC will illuminate YELLOW lights
- All cars accelerate to join SC queue









- "SC procedure"
- All marshal posts will display SC boards and waved yellow flags....LIGHT PANELS "SC"
- All cars, in single file, must catch up the group when safe to do so
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap"
- "SC lights off" after T15 all signalling removed
- Safety car exits via PIT LANE
- No overtaking prior to pass the FINISH line


ONLY TO BE USED AFTER ALL GT4 HAVE COMPLETED MANDATORY PIT STOPS

- "ATTENTION TO ALL TEAMS "PIT ENTRY CLOSED"
- "SC MOVE LEFT ELIGIBLE CARS MOVE RIGHT"
- "START WAVE-BY"
- "WAVE-BY COMPLETED PIT LANE OPEN"







END OF SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE






OVERTAKE ONLY

ON THE CONTROL/FINISH LINE














LATE RACE INCIDENTS



- Incidents that occur towards the end of race:
 - If visibility is good
 - Track not blocked
 - May be covered with yellow flags
 - TEAM MANAGERS will be informed
 - You must slow down, maintain full control
 - ABSOLUTELY NO TRACK LIMITS
 - No overtaking before green flag
 - Respect flags.







Podiums:



All cars required for the Podium will be directed to go towards Parc Ferme in Scrutineering Bay, GARAGE 1-2.

GT3 Overall 1st 2nd 3rd

GT3 Silver-Am 1st 2nd

GT3 Pro-Am 1^{st} 2^{nd} 3^{rd} * only required if GT3 Overall is not all Pro-Am

GT4 Overall 1st 2nd 3rd

GT4 Pro-Am 1st 2nd 3rd

GT4 Silver 1st 2nd 3rd

GT4 Endurance Cup 1st

All podium required drivers, importantly GT3 and GT4 <u>race winning co-drivers</u> to go to SCRUTINEERING immediately at the end of the race for live tv interviews.

ALL CARS ARE TO BE IN PARC FERME CONDITIONS – NO TEAM MEMBERS TO TOUCH THE CARS UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY AN OFFICIAL
