The Stewards issue this bulletin in order to clarify the following points:

1. The Stewards' Office is located on the second floor of the Race Control building behind Race Control.
2. The Race Director's Office is located on the first floor of the Race Control Building on the left hand side.
3. The distance from pit in to pit out is 336 metres and it will take 24.1 seconds to drive through the pit lane when travelling at 50 kph.
4. In the event of a "Drive Through" or "Stop / Go" penalty being imposed post-race it will be converted to a time penalty and added to the elapsed time of the car concerned. That time penalty will be 30 seconds for a "Drive Through" and 35 seconds plus the prescribed stop time for a "Stop / Go" per Article 16.5 of the British GT Championship Sporting Regulations 2026.
5. The Technical Deputies noted in Appendix 2 of the British GT Championship Sporting Regulations 2026 appointed as Judges of Fact for this event are: Stephen Rose, Sue Crook, Matthew Godber, Shefin Shukkoor, Paul Hewer, and Johan Donders.
6. The main Parc Fermé area is located at the rear of garages 1 to 3. All cars not selected to be taken to the main Parc Fermé will be held under Parc Fermé conditions within their allocated garage.
7. Balance of Performance
In accordance with Article 30.1 of the British GT Championship Sporting Regulations 2026, the Stewards confirm that the Balance of Performance document applicable for this competition is the document which can be found at: <https://www.britishgt.com> in the Teams download section; bearing the header: BALANCE OF PERFORMANCE for GT3 and GT4 cars: Silverstone and the title: BOP 22.04.2026 and identified by the footer: Decisions taken by the SRO GT Bureau 22.04.2026
