The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the team representative, have considered the following matter and determined the following:

<b>No / Driver:</b>	90 / Optimum Motorsport (MSUK: 372581)
<b>Session:</b>	Race 1
<b>Time (Fact):</b>	15:24
<b>Fact:</b>	The car controller was not wearing his visor whilst refueling was taking place.
<b>Offence:</b>	Championship Regulation 37.1 - Eye protection not correctly fitted
<b>Decision:</b>	Fine
<b>Fine:</b>	£ 250 GBP
<b>Reason:</b>	The car controller was not wearing his visor whilst refueling was taking place. The team manager admitted this immediately at the hearing that it was an error. The fine would usually be £500 but because of the honest admission of the breach, the fact it is the first offence of the season, and other circumstances £250 is deemed by the Stewards to be an appropriate penalty.
