

Stewards' Decision

The Stewards have received a written request from the Entrant of car #84 for permission to participate in all sessions today having taken the car away from the Event (Stewards Bulletin No. 2, 23 May 2026 at 16:55 refers).

The Stewards have further received a report today from the Championship Eligibility Scrutineer regarding car#84 confirming that a different engine and turbos have been fitted post qualifying. The Championship Eligibility Scrutineer confirms that the necessary checks have been undertaken.

The Stewards grant their permission for car #84 to enter and start the warm up, round 2 (race 8), and round 3 (race 13).

In accordance with BGT Sporting and Technical Regulation 2026, Article 40 as the engine and turbos change was after qualifying the Stewards impose a 10-place grid penalty to be served at the Driver's next race Round 2 (race 8). At this point the Stewards refer to their decision issued on 23 May 2026 at 19:01, stipulating that car #84 must start both races from pit lane.

As both penalties run concurrently, the greater penalty applies and therefore car #84 must start both races from the pit lane.

In accordance with BGT Sporting and Technical Regulation 2026 Article 45.13 the Stewards set out the following procedure the team of car #84 must adopt for Round 2 (race 8) and Round 3 (race 13):

- a. prior to the five-minute board the car may do a lap of the circuit and then return to the pit lane, parking at the pit exit line (the car must not go to its grid position);
- b. at the five-minute board the car must have wheels fitted at the pit exit line;
- c. at the three-minute board the car must be on the ground;
- d. the car may only exit the pit lane when the pit exit signal is green;

- e. if there are two formation laps the car will be allowed to join at the end of the first formation lap.
