The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the drivers and team representatives as well as the Brit GT Driving Standards Advisor, have considered the following matter and determined the following:

Fact:	Cars 8 and 61 made contact at turn 5.
Offence:	Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.
Decision:	No further action
Reason:	The Stewards summoned and heard from the drivers and team representatives. All parties viewed Hayfisher broadcast footage, as well as in car footage from both cars. Cars #8 and #61 had been racing for some laps previously, normally proceeding through T5 in line. On this particular lap, car #8 ran partially wide at T4, and then entered T5 slightly off line and to the left, and in response, car #61 sought to drive into the gap on the right side of car #8 to attempt an overtake. Car #8 then came closer to the apex and the cars touched at the exit of the corner with the left front wing of car #61 hitting the right side door of car #8. Both cars continued. The Stewards therefore consider that neither driver is wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision, and find that no further action is appropriate.
