

Stewards' Bulletin No. 1 (2 pages)

The Stewards issue this bulletin in order to clarify the following points:

1. The Stewards' Office is located in the Race Control Building, ground floor.
2. The Race Director's Office is located in the Race Control Building, first floor.
3. The distance from pit in white line to pit out white line is 246 metres. The timekeepers have announced that the pit lane delta is 22.1 seconds when travelling at 40 kph.
4. In the event of a "Drive Through" or "Stop / Go" penalty being imposed post-race it will be converted to a post race time penalty and added to the elapsed time of the car concerned. That time penalty will be 30 seconds for a "Drive Through" and 35 seconds plus the prescribed stop time for a "Stop / Go" per Article 16.5 of the British GT Championship Sporting Regulations 2026.
5. Current Behaviour Warning Points ("BWP") are:
 - a. Kevin Tse – 1 BWP;
 - b. Mark Smith – 1 BWP;
 - c. Jonathon Beeson – 1 BWP; and
 - d. Charles Clark – 1 BWP.
6. The Technical Deputies noted in Appendix 2 of the British GT Championship Sporting Regulations 2026 appointed as Judges of Fact for this event are: Stephen Rose, Sue Crook, Matthew Godber, and Shefin Shukkoor.
7. The fuel density figure for this weekend will be 0.7542kg/l at 15°C.



8. The main Parc Fermé area is located at Scrutineering Bay. All cars not selected to be taken to the main Parc Fermé will be held under Parc Fermé conditions within their allocated garage.
9. Balance of Performance
