Brief Details:

Car #1 made contact with car #67 at T4. Both drivers have been interviewed. The signal for the end of the race had not been displayed at the time of the collision due to the official time of race finish being 60 mins and 0.3s. The contact occurred after the official finish time. Accordingly the driver of car #1 is found guilty of causing a collision and fined. The official race result was not affected.
