## FANATEC GT WORLD CHALLENGE POWERED BY AWS SPORTING DEROGATION

The Sporting Board has received a request for driver Miguel Ramos to compete in the Spa round of the British GT Championship. As he is not a full-season competitor, permission for this is down to the Sporting Board according to article 30.9 b):

## b) Participation in other series

Participation in Competitions counting towards other Championships or series is not considered as private testing. This includes any official test sessions and all official practice sessions. However, participation in any additional (optional) sessions during these Competitions is not authorised Exception: participation with a GT3 car in any series taking place at the Spa-Francorchamps circuit within the two-week period before the start of the CrowdStrike 24 Hours of Spa is excluded from this authorisation, with the exception of Teams and drivers taking part in any such Series on a full-season basis, or with special derogation from the SRO Sporting Board.

Considering that Miguel Ramos has been out of racing for over six months on medical grounds, and on medical grounds he was unable to take part in the Spa Prologue, the Sporting Board considers this to be force majeure and to allow Ramos to take part in the Spa Speedweek round of the British GT Championship, on the following conditions:

- Ramos will be in a race-by-race car which does not score points
- His team-mate must be another Bronze driver who is not competing in the 2024 edition of the Crowdstrike 24 Hours of Spa.
- Should he be authorised to drive alone in British GT, further restrictions maybe imposed (track time, stint length, driver 1 or 2 doing q1 or q2 etc.)
- In case of 2 drivers Ramos will be Driver 2 for British GT and will take part in Q2 with the Pro drivers.
